2 07-09-2022 Though the present writ petition has been

filed seeking quashing of the notice dated

19.7.2021, issued by the Circle Officer, Dharhara,



District-Munger, under Section 3 of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, but the learned counsel for the petitioner has confined his relief to grant of opportunity to the petitioner to file his show cause reply/ objection before the Circle Officer, Dharhara, District-Munger in the aforesaid encroachment case, whereupon it is prayed that the Circle Officer, Dharhara, District-Munger may be directed to pass appropriate orders under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, after considering the show cause reply/objection, to be filed by the petitioner.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the present writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file objection/show cause reply within a period of four weeks from today in the aforesaid ongoing encroachment case, pending before the Circle Officer, Dharhara, District-Munger, which shall be considered by the Circle Officer, Dharhara, District-Munger and the final order shall be passed under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment



Act, 1956, within a period of twelve weeks,
thereafter.

The present writ petition stands disposed
of on the aforesaid terms.
