2 15-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Obra P.S. Case no. 86 of 2021 instituted for the offence
under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 325, 307/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioner has assaulted
the informant due to which he received injury in little finger of
his hand and head injury.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no
offence. Doctor has opined the nature of injury is simple which



is mentioned in the impugned order. General and omnibus allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. Neither the petitioner was arrested nor any incriminating article has been recovered from his possession.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Obra P.S. Case no. 86 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Daudnagar, Aurangabad subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
