ORAL ORDER**

2 15-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
counsel for the Informant and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 148, 341,
323, 325, 307, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of assault upon the informant
and other family members due to which, they sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He
further submits that there is general and omnibus allegation
against the petitioner and specific allegation of assault is against
co-accused Yuvraj Kumar and not against this petitioner.
Petitioner has clean antecedent.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Aurangabad (Bihar) in connection with Fesar Police Station Case No.58 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
