2 07-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the Vigilance.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the informant alleges that petitioner sought appointment as *Panchayat* Teacher based on forged and fabricated marksheet of matriculation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, it is next submitted that the FIR came to be instituted based on an *ex-parte* inquiry conducted behind the back of the petitioner, it is also submitted that had an opportunity been given to the



petitioner to explain his side of the case, perhaps the present FIR would not have been instituted, it is also submitted that the services of the petitioner till date has not been terminated.

Learned Spl.P.P. for the Vigilance opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Bakhri P.S. Case No. 151 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
