3 19-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Four weeks' time is granted to the counsel for the
petitioner to remove the defect(s) as pointed out by the office.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence under Sections-302, 102(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code
and 27 of the Arms Act.

Earlier prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected
taking into account that the petitioner was one of the assailants.

A report was called for from the trial court.

It has been reported that the case is fixed for
argument.

Considering the nature of accusation and stage of the
case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner in



connection with Sessions Trial No. 738 of 2016 arising out of
Gopalganj P.S. Case No. 18 of 2010 is rejected.

The trial court is directed to take all necessary steps to
conclude the trial of the petitioner at the earliest.
