Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned  
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the  
offences punishable under Sections 328, 302/34 of the Indian  
Penal Code.

As per prosecution case, it is alleged by the informant  
namely Bhim Manjhi that his daughter Meena Devi married with  
Munna Pramanik about 15 years ago and she has not having a  
baby. On this, the husband and her in-laws tortured her  
physically and mentally and on 28.04.2021 his son-in-law called  
him and told that his daughter is very ill. Informant and her son



went to the house of the son-in-law where they found the dead body of his daughter Meena Devi and son-in-law fled away.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has clean antecedents and he has been falsely implicated in the present case on the ground that the petitioner is the husband of the deceased. Further submits that it appears from the F.I.R. that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and during investigation nothing has come against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 30.04.2021.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Chandan P.S. Case No. 63 of 2021, with the following conditions :-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the



witness, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

(3) And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
