2 21-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30 (a),(c) (d) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

As per the prosecution case, 70 liters of country made liquor has been recovered from the bank of river Ganga.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners and they are no way concerned with the alleged recovery. Petitioners have got clean



antecedent.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts of the case and clean antecedent of the petitioners, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/ surrender within a period of six weeks from today shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Raghapur PS case No. 87/2022, subject to conditions laid down u/s 438(2) of the Cr. P. C.
