2 12-08-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“ I. For direction to the respondent authorities to remove the encroachment from a part of the individual raiyati land bearing (1) Khesera no. 1387 under KhaTA NO. 114, Area 6 ½ decimal and (2) Khesera no. 1388 under Khata no. 570, Area 41 Decimal, (Total Area 47 ½ decimal situated at Village Hasanpur Daxini, Wrd. no. 02, Police Station and Circle- Mahnar, District Vaishali for constructing village street under M.G. NREGA/ others Scheme from semi constructed brick soled without consent of the petitioners.

II, For disposal of the instant writ petition in the light of the order dated 02.05.2011 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 2490 of 2020, an identical matter batch of case involving similar issues came for consideration of the rival stand (Annexure2).”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the District Magistrate, Vaishali for redressal of their aforesaid grievances.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed, however, with liberty to the petitioners to approach the District Magistrate, Hajipur at Vaishali by filing appropriate representation and in case such a representation is filed within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be



disposed off, in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks, thereafter.
