2 27-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 32(2) of the Bihar Excise Act read with Section 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 536.400 litres of liquor from a pickup van.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession and his name transpired based on secret information petitioner, it is further submitted that he is neither the owner nor the driver of the



pickup van. It is thus submitted that police has tried to falsely implicate the petitioner when he is a person with clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Bachhwara P.S. Case No. 61 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
