2 21-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defect(s) as pointed out by the office within a period
of four weeks.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section-392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case in short is that in course of returning
home from Koilwar, the motorcycle of the informant was
snatched away by unknown miscreants.

It has been submitted that there is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 16-06-2022. Charge sheet has
already been submitted in this case. The petitioner is not named



in the FIR. The name of the petitioner has transpired in the present case in course of investigation. The petitioner has not been put on TIP to ascertain his participation in the alleged offence.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Koilwar P.S. Case No. 06 of 2022.
