2 30-09-2022 Heard Mr. Salahuddin Khan learned counsel for the
petitioner and Ms Usha Kumari, learned counsel for the State.

At the outset, when the attention of the learned
counsel for the petitioner was drawn towards Section 14-A(1) of
the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of
Atrocities) Act, he conceded that against the order taking
cognizance of the offence inter alia under the Scheduled Castes
and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, an
application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal
Procedure would not be maintainable. He submitted that he may



be permitted to withdraw the present application with liberty to
file an appropriate appeal in accordance with law challenging
the impugned order.

Leave is granted. The application is disposed of.
