ORAL ORDER

2 29-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Lauriya P.S. Case no. 84 of 2021 instituted for the offence punishable under Section 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioners along with other family members have tortured in various ways to the complainant due to non-fulfillment dowry demand and finally they ousted her after snatching her belongings.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that petitioner nos. 1 and 2 are father-in-law and mother-in-law respectively and petitioner no. 3 is brother-in-law of the informant and they all have been falsely implicated in this



case. They have never demanded any thing from the informant. They have no concern with the daily activity of the informant and her husband. They are living separately. The sole responsibility to take care of wife is upon husband of the informant and not against his other family members.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Lauriya P.S. Case no. 84 of 2021, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Bettiah, West Champaran subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
