Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for following reliefs:

1. That this is an application for issuance of an
appropriate writ, order or direction quashing the
order contained in Memo No. 680 dated 29.07.2021
issued by the S.D.O., Kahalgaon whereby the P.D.S.

Licence of the petitioner bearing Licence No. 41/16 has been cancelled in as much as the order impugned suffers from procedural defects as well as violative of Principles of natural justice.

Further direct the licensing authorities to restore the licence of the petitioner and supply the goods.

And for any other relief (s) for which the petitioner is found to be entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.

Petitioner has approached this Court without exhausting the statutory remedy of appeal against the impugned order, as such, petitioner is granted liberty to file an appeal before the appellate authority against the order passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer Kahalgaon, District- Bhagalpur -cum-licensing authority, and if any such appeal is filed within 4 weeks from today, the appellate authority shall condone the delay in filing the appeal and shall decide the appeal on its own merit preferably within 8 weeks from the date of its filing.

With aforesaid liberty, the writ petition stands disposed
of.
