Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction, particularly in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant sum of Rs. 2,61,330/-, which includes 1,61,360 the due amount for the work done under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme, Bihar, for the scheme bearing Yojna No. 5/2013-14 and the total money of the



estimated scheme was amounting to Rs. 1,99,900/- out of which an amount of Rs. 38,570/- only has been paid to the writ petitioner for payment of the amount to the labours working under the scheme, and the rest amount Rs.1,00,000/- has been claimed as compensation for mental and physical harassment caused to the petitioner in perusing the claim before the respondent authorities since last more than 4 years.”

However, in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.
