APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 413 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30 and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is a case of recovery of about 330 liters of country made liquor from a motorcycle.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that he has no concern with the seized liquor and vehicle and no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious or constructive possession of the petitioner and petitioner has not been apprehended at the spot. Petitioner has



got clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Nautan P.S. Case No. 397 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
