Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That the petitioner craves indulgence of this Hon'ble Court for issuance of an appropriate Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ/Writs, Order/Orders, Direction/Directions, Command/Commands for directing the respondents to pay the agreement amount to the petitioner as the petitioner has completed the construction work of Water Supply for Minority Girls Hostel, M.J.M. Mahila College, Naya Tola, Katihar.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, more so in view of the disputed question of fact, fairly states that petitioner be permitted to take recourse to such equally, efficacious alternative remedies as are available in accordance with law.

Permission granted.
