APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 354(B), 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assault upon the informant and her family members by the accused persons including the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that specific allegation of assault by means of Dabiya is against co-accused Sonu Kumar Yadav and not this petitioner. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the



prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Araria in connection with Narpatganj P.S. Case No. 254 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
