2 28-04-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Ghoshi P.S. Case No. 108/2021 registered for the offences punishable under Section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the nature of allegations and also considering the fact that petitioner No. 1 is 70 years old and petitioner No. 2 is a lady and there is no chance of their



absconding, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad, in connection with Ghoshi P.S. Case No. 108/2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
