Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“That this application by way of Public Interest of Litigation for issuance of appropriate writ/writs specially in the nature of mandamus commanding upon the special instruction to give respondents 1 to 7 in accordance with law facts and circumstances of the case mentioned in the petition to start which is to be investigated through the Central Bureau of Investigation that Government property (Railway station and coaches with AC an Non AC were



targeted) or Honorable Patna High Court wishes to get the investigation done by any other investigation agency by student & anti-social elements in the State of Bihar with a massive and gruesome scene. As the court deems fit.”

Mr. Rajesh Kumar Jaiswal, who is appearing in Court in-person, unconditionally, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition as also each one of the averments made therein.

Ordinarily, we would have imposed very heavy cost, but considering the fact that petitioner, who is appearing in-person, is not familiar with the niceties of law and pleadings; and there is nothing on record showing petitioner's past conduct of undertaking such a misadventure, we refrain from doing so.

We have no doubt that the petition was filed with oblique motive, if not, is more than at least gaining publicity.

With a warning to the petitioner not to indulge in such misadventure in future, we allow him to withdraw the petition.

Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
