Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



1. That by this writ application the petitioner craves indulgence of this Hon'ble Court for issuance of appropriate writ / direction / order to the respondents for release of the Truck of the petitioner seized under the Bihar Minerals (concession prevention of illegal mining, transport and storage) (Amendment) Rules, 2021 and even confiscating authority and the order for release of the truck vide order dated 08.06.2022 passed in Misc. (Mining) Case No. 33/2022 by the Collector, Bhojpur, Arrah, the truck has not been released by the S.H.O., Azimabad Police Station, Bhojpur in an illegal manner.

In view of the intervening developments, Shri Baxi S.R.P. Sinha, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, does not press the present petition reserving liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings, if any, claiming compensation in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the State states that the petitioner was always at fault.

Statement taken on record, though we refrain from making any observation with respect thereto.
