Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



- I. For direction to respondent authority to prevent ongoing corruption in several scheme of government under Pirapur Mathura, Goraul Block.
- II. For direction to conduct inquiry of "Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna of Pirapur panchayat and further conduct inquiry regarding conduct of Awas Assistant and Awas Observer of said panchayat.
- III. For any other relief for which the petitioner is found entitle in case and circumstances of the case and or the sake justice.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, before the appropriate forum/Tribunal, the same



shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law.

Needless to add, period for which the petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court, shall be excluded for the purpose of computing limitation.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues are left open.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
