Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

directing the Respondents to make the full and final payment to the petitioner in connection with agreement No. 71F2/2021-22, and Agreement No. 72F2/2021-22 entered into between the petitioner and the Respondent No. 6.”

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.
