ORAL ORDER

2 21-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Amarpur P.S. Case no. 198 pf 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 308, 504, 506, 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, several accused persons including the petitioner after entering into the house of the informant while he was alone, committed mar-pit and also took away a sum of Rs. 10,000/- from his pocket.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no



offence. He has got no criminal antecedent. Specific allegation of inflicting knife blow is against co-accused Akanksha Kumari by which petitioner has received abrasion in his finger. Allegation against the petitioner is general and omnibus.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Amarpur P.S. Case no. 198 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM-cum-Sub-judge-II-cum-ASJ-1, Banka subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
