ORAL ORDER

3 08-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned APP
for the State and perused the case diary.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363 and 365 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of abduction of the son of the
informant by the petitioner and other accused persons.



It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that petitioners have not played any role in abduction of the victim and the victim has been recovered from the house of one Anil Singh and not from the house of these petitioners and this fact has been stated in para-16 of the case diary. Petitioners have clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail and submitted that from perusal of the case diary witnesses have supported the case of the prosecution.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioners, above named in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Jamui in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 156 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
