Additional Public Prosecutor for the State through Video
Conferencing.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,
arises out of Mashrakh Police Station Case No. 536 of 2020,
disclosing offences under Sections 30(a), 38, 41 of Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Considering the report of the local police, it has
reported that the recovery has been made from the joint property
of the petitioner and that is not the exclusive property of the
petitioner. It is also submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid fact, the application for
anticipatory bail is allowed.



Let the petitioner, named above, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within eight weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Saran, in connection with Mashrakh Police Station Case No. 536 of 2020, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
