4 19-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners,

informant and learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 147, 149, 341, 447, 323, 324, 325, 307,

354(B), 379, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks

permission to withdraw the petition with regard to

petitioner No. 2 namely Pawan Thakur.



Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the petition with respect to petitioner No. 2 is dismissed as withdrawn.

The accusations are of making assault, outraging the modesty and snatching gold ornament.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners and the informant are agnates and in the background of some land dispute, this false case has been lodged against the petitioners. There is counter version of the occurrence also and petitioners' side also received injuries. There is no accusation of repeating the blow. Except one injury, all the injuries are simple in nature. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedents.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, except petitioner No. 2, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be



released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 154 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
