2 30-11-2022 Though, the present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to either renew the passport of the petitioner or reissue the same, however, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to file a fresh application for issuance of passport, annexing the Secondary School Examination certificate wherein the date of birth of the petitioner has been recorded as 24.10.1989, alongwith other certificates as also seeks a direction upon the Passport Issuing Authority to take appropriate decision, upon



the application to be filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, expeditiously.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition stands disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application for issuance of passport, before the competent Passport Issuing Authority, who shall take appropriate decision, in accordance with law.
