Conferencing.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,
arises out of Hilsa Police Station Case No. 423 of 2020,
disclosing offences under Section 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner is mother-in-law and the allegations
are false and the informant has not supported the prosecution
case in the trial of the husband and the father-in-law and they
have been acquitted. He also submits that both the minor
children, aged about 4 years and 3 years, are staying with the
petitioner.



Considering the aforesaid circumstances, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Let the petitioner, named above, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the Court below within ten weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hilsa, Nalanda, in connection with Hilsa Police Station Case No. 423 of 2020, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
