Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



- (I) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of **MANDAMUS**, restraining the Respondent Authorities for transfer of the present incumbent holding the post of Incharge Medical Officer, Primary Health Centre, Bikram, Patna on the ground that the petitioner has come to know through the reliable sources that steps are being taken by the Respondents for transfer of present incumbent posted as the Incharge Medical Officer, Primary Health Centre, Bikram, Patna, who had unearthed a big scam in the purchase of different articles for the benefits of the patient of Primary Health Centre, Bikram.
- (II) For issuance of any other appropriate writ/writs, order / orders, direction/directions for which the writ petitioner shall be found entitled under the facts and circumstances of the case.

As orally prayed for, Station House Officer of Bikram Police Station, District- Patna is impleaded as Party Respondent No. 10.

Registry to make necessary correction in the memo of parties, both on the physical as also the digital file.

Shri S.B.K. Manglam, learned counsel for the petitioner, states that petitioner would be content if a direction is issued to the newly added respondent, namely Station House Officer of Bikram Police Station, District- Patna to complete the investigation at the earliest.

Petition is disposed of with direction to Respondent No. 10, namely, Station House Officer of Bikram Police Station, District- Patna to expedite the investigation in relation to Bikram Police Station Case No. 222 of 2022 dated 21st of May,



2022, registered for the offence under Sections 379, 409/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Needless to add, such investigation shall be carried out strictly in accordance with law.

Interlocutory Application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
