The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 256 of 2020 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 342,323,307,498(A) 379, 504,506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

In view of the fact that the petitioners are mother-in-law and sister-in-law of the alleged victim, their application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of ten weeks from today, on



furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapara in connection with Sonpur P.S. Case No. 256 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
