The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Inerwa P.S. Case No. 75 of 2020 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341/323/354(B)/504/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the POCSO Act.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are parents of the main accused, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.
