ORAL JUDGMENT

(Per: HONOURABLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE)

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(The proceedings of the Court are being conducted by Hon'ble the Chief Justice/ Hon'ble Judges through Video Conferencing from their residential offices/residences. Also, the Advocates and the Staffs joined the proceedings through Video Conferencing from their residences/offices.)

The petitioner has prayed for the following relief/s :-

- i. to remove and shift the electric pole and 11 K.V. electric wire which is running over the residential house situated on plot no. 228 at village Natha Kunwar, Mahadipur, District – Nalanda (Bihar),
- ii. to install the electric Pole and 11 K.V. electric wire run through side of residential house of petitioner on Government land,
- iii. for giving direction to the Circle Officer, Ekangarsarai, District – Nalanda (Respondent no. 7) to provide the deatail of government land near plot no. 228 village Natha Kunwar, Mahadipur, District – Nalanda (Bihar),
- iv. for giving direction to government respondents authority to protect the life and property of petitioner and his family which is in danger and serious threat of the electric current of 11 K.V. which is running over the residential house of petitioner and/or
- v. for grant of any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner is entitled.



After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other remedies as are otherwise permissible and admissible in accordance with law as also represent to the appropriate authority, venting out the grievances, subject-matter of the present petition.

Prayer allowed. Liberty, as prayed for, is granted.

Without expressing any opinion on merits, leaving all questions of fact and law open, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

We expect that the appropriate authority shall consider and decide the petitioner's application/request expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of its presentation.

Needless to say that while considering such request, principles of natural justice shall be followed and due opportunity of hearing afforded to the parties.

If aggrieved by the said order, the petitioner shall have liberty to approach this Court by way of separate petition(s), if so required and desired.



Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
