ORAL ORDER

3 11-10-2022 Vide order dated 30.09.2022, the petition of petitioner no.4 has already been dismissed as withdrawn.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner nos. 1, 2 and 3 and learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 333, 188 and 171(E) of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of discharging the official duties by the accused persons.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners



that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners and no specific overt-act against them.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioners, namely, Binay Gupta @ Binay Kumar Gupta, Bhola Sah and Rahul Kumar Das, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of ACJM, Udakishunganj, District- Madhepura in connection with Udakishunganj P.S. Case No. 135 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
