3 29-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

Earlier the bail application of petitioner was rejected
vide order dated 11.10.2017 with an observation to conclude the
trial as soon as possible preferably within a period of nine
months.

It is submitted that even after lapse of more than four
years not a single witness has been examined on behalf of
prosecution. Trial court report reveals that till date not a single
witness has been examined.

Considering the period of custody and tardy progress
of trial, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged
on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand)



with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge 5th, Gaya in connection with Dumaria P.S. Case No. 11 of 2015 corresponding to Sessions Trial No. 234 of 2018 (33/2019).
