2 11-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in a case registered under section 392 of the
Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, on the informant
stopping his pick up van for checking, it is stated that four
accused persons came on three motorcycles and took away his
pick up van.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the F.I.R. was registered against unknown. Referring to the
order of the learned trial court rejecting the application for bail
of the petitioner, it is submitted that the name of the petitioner
transpired in the confessional statement of Manish Kumar made



before police. The said Manish Kumar has been enlarged on bail vide order dated 7.10.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. no.19394 of 2021. The petitioner is in custody since 8.7.2021 but has not been put on T.I. parade and chargesheet has been submitted. No incriminating article has been recovered from the petitioner's possession. He has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case together with chargesheet having been submitted in the case and grant of bail to Manish Kumar on whose confessional statement the name of the petitioner transpired, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Sahebpur Kamal P.S. Case no.314 of 2019 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai.
