4 18-01-2022 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, through Video Conferencing.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Raxaul Police Station Case No. 67 of 2004 (G.R. No. 203 of 2004), disclosing offences under Sections 22, 23 and 25 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

At the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner has taken this Court to the final form. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that police after investigation saying that there was no evidence against the petitioner, the learned Court below has taken cognizance after differing with the final form.



Considering the aforesaid fact, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Let the petitioner, named above, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within eight weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-VII, East Champaran at Motihari, in connection with Raxaul Police Station Case No. 67 of 2004 (G.R. No. 203 of 2004).
