2 18-04-2022 The present petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 20.2.2020 passed in Criminal Revision No. 164 of 2019 by the Presiding Officer, Fast Track Court-1st, Bhojpur at Ara whereby and whereunder the revision petition has been dismissed and the order dated 20.9.2019 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Class, Bhojpur at Ara in Complain Case No. 1151(C)/2019, summoning the petitioners under Section 204 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for



the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 325, 379, 504 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, has been affirmed.
