The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Neemchak Bathani P.S. Case No.24 of 2020 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to mistake in the certificate occurred by the Bihar School Examination Board, Patna. It is further submitted that the petitioner has not filed any forged certificate for appointment on the post of Panchayat Teacher. He also submits that only change in serial number of certificate is not likely to give any benefit to the petitioner. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances

of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate X, Gaya in connection with Neemchak Bathani P.S. Case No.24 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
