APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is expected to
honour his undertaking given in the instant case for depositing
the requisite court fee and to remove the defect(s) as pointed out
by the office when called upon to do so by the office.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323,
324, 504, 506, 448, 380, 384, 379 and 307/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

It is a case of assault by the accused persons and also



taking away Rs.3,000/- and some articles from the house of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that good sense prevailed between the parties and there is no dispute between them as there has been compromise between the parties, which is annexed as Annexure-3 to this petition. Petitioners have clean antecedent as stated in para-3 of the petition.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Bhagalpur in connection with Ishakchak P.S. Case No. 60 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
