3 21-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Chhatapur P.S. Case no. 269 of 2020 instituted for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 325, 379, 384, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, several accused persons including the petitioners armed with different weapons were forcibly harvesting the crops of the informant. On protest made by him, accused Devendra Yadav pointed three nut pistol and orther the petitioners to kill the informant. His wife and son were also beaten



up by farsa and sword.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. There is case and counter case. Both parties have sustained injuries in the alleged incident. Injury received by the injured Shyama Yadav is grievous in nature but on right hand which is a non-vital organ. There is no allegation of repetition of blow.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Chhatapur P.S. Case no. 269 of 2020, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Supaul subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
