Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 373 of 2021 for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The postmortem report of the deceased does not support the allegations as there is no ante-mortem injury on the deceased whereas, the allegation is that the accused persons have assaulted the deceased.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., East Champaran, Motihari, in connection with Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 373 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
