2 11-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the

informant for non-fulfillment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the

petitioners that petitioners are father-in-law and mother-

in-law of the deceased. The victim has herself committed

suicide. There is no eye witness to the occurrence. The



husband of the deceased is in custody. The petitioners had no concern with the day-to-day affairs of the deceased and her husband.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gopalganj in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 183 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
