2. In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for
following reliefs:

“1. That this writ application is
being filed for issuance of writ nature of
mandamus for direction to the respondent
consider the application dated 02.11.2020
filed by the petitioner and further issue
direction to respondents consider the
application of the petitioner and is sued
selection letter on the post of peon in
pursuance of the advertisement No. 01/2013
and further give other legal consequential
benefit to the petitioner.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not pointed out
as to how and in what manner he has vested right in seeking the



aforesaid relief. In other words, he has not furnished the select list or questioned the validity of selection and appointment of any third person. In the absence of these factual aspects, the petitioner is not entitled to the aforesaid relief.
