ORAL ORDER

5 13-07-2022 Petitioner has challenged the order dated 27.07.2019

passed by the Assistant Labour Commissioner-cum-Competent

Authority under the Minimum Wages Act.

At the outset, counsel for the respondents has raised
an objection that the petitioner has not availed the remedy under
sub-section (6) of Section 20 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948.

A query being put to counsel for the petitioner
whether he is ready to avail the remedy, now he is agreeable. In
case he files an appeal before the Appellate Authority within
three weeks from today, no question of limitation shall be



allowed to stand in his way and appeal shall be decided on merits.

No coercive action shall be taken for a period of three weeks from today.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
