A.P.P. for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to  
remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within a period  
of four weeks.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in Goreakothi  
P.S. Case No. 155 of 2019 registered for the offences  
punishable under Section 365 of the Indian Penal Code pending  
in the Court of learned C.J.M., Siwan.

The allegation against the petitioner is that she ran  
away with new born child and absconded for almost one year.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner  
that no such occurrence as alleged ever took place. She has  
been falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled



against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State vehemently opposing the bail petition submitted that the allegation levelled against the petitioner is serious in nature, hence she does not deserve anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of case and particularly considering the criminal antecedents, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected. However, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court below within six weeks from today and seek regular bail and the learned Court below would pass order on the same day in accordance with law without being prejudiced by this order.
