2 31-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove
the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of four
weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in Bhimpur P.S.
Case No. 23 of 2019 registered under Section 366(A)/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of assisting the co-
accused in abducting the informant's daughter.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner
has been falsely implicated in the present case. The alleged
occurrence is said to have taken place on 22-03-2019 and the case



was instituted on 01-04-2019. The victim has been recovered. The specific allegation is against co-accused namely Babloo Mukhiya. So far petitioner is concerned, she is a lady. She has been made accused in the present case for oblique reasons. It has further been stated that the victim has solemnized marriage with the co-accused Babloo Kumar Mukhiya.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Supaul in connection with Bhimpur P.S. Case No. 23 of 2019 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
