4 01-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506 of

the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks

permission to withdraw the petition with regard to

petitioner No. 1.

Permission is accorded.



Accordingly, the petition with respect to petitioner No. 1 is dismissed as withdrawn.

It appears that the application with regard to petitioner No. 2 has already been withdrawn vide order dated 04.07.2022.

It is alleged that all the accused persons including the petitioners assaulted the informant and others. It is only alleged against the petitioner No. 3 that he fired indiscriminately from his pistol.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner No. 3 that he has falsely been implicated in this case. The specific accusation of making assault to the informant and others is not against the petitioner No. 3. It is only alleged against this petitioner that he made indiscriminate firing but no one received any fire arm injury. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner No. 3 has no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner No. 3, above named, in the event of his



arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Saran at Chapra in connection with Daudpur P.S. Case No. 14 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
