2 21-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P.
for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period of
four weeks.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 201 and 120(B)/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner
is a person with clean antecedent.

The informant alleges that he found his niece murdered
and her body was kept concealed in the mud of river Beki under the
bushes of water hyacinth thus based on suspicion alleges that the
husband of the deceased and his family members killed his niece as
Shyam Sundar Rishidev was married from before.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner



has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not related to the husband of the deceased and is a co-villager and the entire allegation hinges around suspicion. It is next submitted that co-accused Manju Devi and Tara Devi have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 10.11.2022 in Cr. Misc. No. 54789 of 2022.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Kochadhaman P.S. Case No. 108 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
