**ORAL ORDER**

6      21-11-2022      Heard the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 341, 323, 307, 379, 504, 506/34 of IPC.

Allegedly, the petitioners along with other accused persons assaulted the informant's side by means of deadly weapons due to which they sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such



occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is no specific overt act against the petitioners. There is a case and counter-case between the parties. He further submits that both sides have sustained injuries. Petitioner nos.1, 2 and 4 have no criminal antecedent and petitioner no.3 has one criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since there is no specific overt act against the petitioners, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in Maner P.S. Case No.550 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
