3 26-09-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“(i) To issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ or writs, direction or directions commanding upon respondent authorities for payment of compensation amount of Rs.10,000,00/- (Ten lacs) as high tension power distribution line (11 KV) has been established over plot no. 3259, over which petitioner’s house is built and around 100 of Sagwan trees were standing which has been cut by respondent authorities. Further the 11 KV kline has also been established over Plot no. 3248 and 3112 damaging the standing crop of wheat and in



future also there would not be any cultivation as wide area has been covered for erection of electric towers. All three plots belong to petitioner situated at village Maulanagar, P.S.-Atri, District – Gaya.

(ii) To pass any such other order or orders as the Hon’ble Court may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

On 16.09.2022, we had passed the following order:

“Despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

However, in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.

List this case on 22nd of September, 2022, in the category of “Order Matters.”

Even today, despite repeated calls and pass over, none appears for the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed for default.
